

ORDINANCE 21-103  
APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES  
WATER ORDINANCE

The City of Courtland on the fourth day of March 2021 approves the proposed amendment to the Municipal Utilities Water Ordinance as stated:

Amendment to 801.01 Connection to Municipal Water System

- **801.01 Connection to Municipal Water System. (Page 174)**
  - **Subdivision 6. Repair of Leaks**
    - The consumer or owner shall be responsible for maintaining the water service pipe up to but not including the corporation stop into the building served. If the consumer or owner fails to repair any leak in such service pipe within 24 hours after notice by the City, the City may turn the water off. When the waste of water is great or damage is likely to result from the leak, the City may turn the water off immediately upon giving of notice if repair is not commenced immediately.
    - If repairs to the water service pipe up to the corporation stop falls within the City right-of-way or under the City street or alley, the City and consumer/owner will share in the cost of the repairs of damage within the right-of-way and City street or alley to original state.
    - If the consumer or owner placed an asphalt/bituminous or concrete driveway over the water service pipe, the consumer or owner will be responsible for the repairs of the damage to the paved or concrete driveway up to the City street. If the damage goes into the street, the City will share responsibility with consumer or owner on the cost for the repairs to the City street.
    - Damage repair costs that are deemed excessive will be taken under consideration by the City Council for further evaluation to determine cost share of responsible parties involved.
